The Greenwich Police Department is accepting applications for the Spring 2013 Citizen's Police Academy Class. The 7 week session will commence on Thursday April 25th 2013 and meet twice a week from 6:30—9:00 p.m. * Graduation will be held on Thursday June 4th 2013.

The Citizen's Police Academy is a program that provides Greenwich residents with a first hand overview of the law enforcement and community related functions of the Greenwich Police Department.

Instructors for the program will be highly trained and experienced Greenwich Police Officers. There is no fee for the seven week program. ** Any Greenwich resident **18** years of age or older may apply. Seating will be limited to 40 persons.

Due to the high demand of this class, qualified applicants will be subject to a lottery drawing to determine the class roster.

* Two Saturday Sessions are scheduled for May 11th and May 25th (11:00am to 3:00pm) - Hours are subject to change.

**Applicants must be Greenwich residents and should confirm that they will be available for each class of instruction.
